You will be given your location when you check in on the day of the Fair.

Vendors/Exhibitors Booths must be completely set-up by 11:30 am. No vehicles will be allowed on the grounds before 8:30 am. To prevent accident or injury, any Vendor/Exhibitor wishing to leave early **MUST** notify a Fair official. With permission, booths that can be packed-up and “walked-out” will be allowed to do so. The Vendor/Exhibitor is responsible for leaving the area in the condition that it was originally received, i.e. removal of all debris such as boxes and trash. All vendors must vacate the site no later than 5:00 pm. You will receive a confirmation email upon receipt of your registration. This event occurs rain or shine!

Food vendors. Food Vendors must submit proof of a valid permit from the Orange County Department of Health or NYS Department of Agriculture and Markets. Vendors will also be required to show proof of liability insurance.

Whenever possible, all written handouts should be in English and Spanish.

Absolutely no unattended vehicles may be left on the grounds.
